

## ANTOINE'S BIOGRAPHY

Antoine de Saint-Exupéry was born in June 29<sup>th</sup> 1900. He lost his father when he was 4 years old and grew up in the female environment of an aristocratic family in the city of Lyon. Finished high school in 1917, in the Marianist school Villa Saint-Jean in Freiburg, and after being rejected in the naval Academy, he became a pilot when he was fulfilling the military service in 1921.

Joined the pilot squad that covered the sections of "The Line". At the end of 1927 was assigned as chief of scale to the Cabo Juby, where he staved his literary vocation. In 1928 he moved to South America. In 1929 was published *Courrier Sud* and at the end of 1930 *Vol de Nuit*, with which he won the Femina award.

In Argentina he met who will be his wife, Consuelo Suncin.

Since 1932 he dedicates himself to the journalism and the writing, doing reports, but without leaving the aviation.

In the spring of 1944 was destined to Córcega and then to Corsica. He never returned from the flight.
